

## Yr.3 WHAT DID JESUS DO? (2.3, 2.25)

*AT1 (L2) 2:3 stories of the lives of key religious people, the significance of these in their own lives and in the lives of believers today*

*AT2 2:25 examples of the ways in which personal and religious beliefs may influence their behaviour and that of others*

L. O. To understand that Jesus did amazing things to show what God was like.

Expected Outcomes: the chn will:-

- be able to explain what a miracle is
- know that Jesus used miracles to explain what God was like
- understand that Christians believe that God listens to people when they pray

Briefly re-cap what we learned about Jesus last week. Make the point that Jesus pointed people towards God.

Briefly tell story of water into wine using water and food colouring.

Explain that this is only a trick but Christians believe Jesus did amazing things which can't be explained. These are called miracles.

Using an interactive version tell the story of Jesus calming the storm.

Ask the chn what surprises them about the story? Do they ever feel scared?

Using a finger draw a big wavy line across the palm of their hand as they think of something scary.

Make the point that when the disciples were scared they talked to Jesus.

Christians today talk to God and Jesus in heaven about how they are feeling. Draw a calm wave over their palms to illustrate the calmness we can feel when we share how we are feeling.

To do:

- Make their own paper plate boat with moving background
- Ext sheets
